### Rules and Regulations

1. XXIII Summer Music Academy in Zagan will start **August 01 at 11:00** in a Kurlandzka Hall in Palace of Culture.
2. Participants may come at **31.07.2010** (Food will not be provided before August 01, 2010).
3. Completion of the course will take place **August 14 at 11:00**
4. Students are required to provide their arrival and departure dates on their application
5. Upon arrival, participants are required to report to the office on 14th Street Pomorska Between **8:00 and 20:00**.
6. **In order to qualify to participate in the XXIII LAM is sent to the June 20 application card on the office address (enclosing a photocopy of the advance payment in the amount of PLN 600) to the following address:**

**Included must be a proof of having paid a non -refundable down payment in the amount of PLN 600**

7. The tuition is nonrefundable
8. Payment for meals and housing will be collected during registration at the main office or to the PKO bank account
9. Completion of these formalities shall not preclude participation in the Course.
10. Students are guaranteed FIVE 45 minute lessons with their chosen professor and in addition it is possible to observe lessons of other professors.
11. Fees – Accreditation – 1500 zł - obligatory
  - a. Cost of Meals and Housing on the Internet – (1-14.08) **630zł**
  - b. Cost of Housing in the selected date (per day) – **25zł**
  - c. Cost of Meals in the selected date (per day) – **25zł**

12. Housing and meal plans can be paid to the PKO bank account with an annotation *payment for housing and food*
13. Students under the age of 16 must have a chaperone
14. Students at the course will have the opportunity to work with accompanists, so it is mandatory for students to bring piano parts for the accompanists for all the pieces they plan to work on
15. Participants preparing for the competitions will have the opportunity to present its program in the halls of the Palace of Culture (several times if necessary).
16. The course has a tradition of giving students an opportunity to perform at numerous concerts and recitals:
  - “Our Laureates” for winners of competitions in 2008/09
  - Daily concerts of students participating in the course
  - Concerts given by Professors and invited artists
  - Opportunity to play solo in local Churches
  - All performances are recorded by video camera and DVDs available to participants
  - Portions of performances video and photo are published on the Internet
  - All participants will receive a CD with the diploma
15. The Zagan Summer Academy is not responsible for accidents and theft.
